

Position: Mini Coordinator

Role and Responsibilities:

- Plan, Coordinate and Supervision of the Summer Mini Program (U6-U8, Girls and Boys). Includes developing practice plans and distribution to the other coaches.
- Organize/Participate/Coach Mini Program Practices with volunteer and staff coaches
- Communications with Parents and coaches throughout the season regarding practices and Jamborees, as well as any special events.
- Participate/Coach at Saturday Jamborees. U8 Jamborees are held every Saturday throughout the summer except for holiday weekends. (Rain days are on Sunday's)
- Organize Storm's U8 Jamboree which will happen one Saturday in the summer. Coordinate with other Storm members and volunteers needed to hold this event.
- Coach U9, or U10 team or possibly a U12 team. This will include practices and games. As the coach, develop practice plans as well as providing communications to parents.
- Assist coaches of other teams at practice when not with the minis or own teams.
- Assist in set up and tear down of the practice field
- Assist in maintaining the organization of the storage POD containing the Club equipment. POD is located at the practice field.
- Submit weekly timecards
- Hours of work at the field are generally Monday-Friday, 5pm - 9pm, and Saturdays 9-3 for Jamborees.
- Guaranteed 30 hrs per week

Qualifications and Experience

- Candidates must be between the ages of 15 and 30, as per Canada Summer Jobs Guidelines
- Completion of a Criminal Records Check and a Vulnerable Sector Search
- Completion of both CSA Community Coaching course (Fundamentals, Active Start)
- Completion of Making Ethical Decisions Workshop
- Completion of Respect in Sport
- Awareness of the Canadian Soccer Association Long Term Player Development framework
- Playing experience at Provincial or University level is desirable
- Experience of coaching U6 to U10 is desirable
- Ability to communicate with and inspire young players
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
